strength, your ability to remember increases when you exercise your memory and nurture it with a good diet and other healthy habits. There are a number of steps you can take to improve your memory and retrieval capacity. Here are some general guidelines to help you improve your memory –

✓ Pay attention. It takes about eight seconds of intent focus to process

a piece of information through your hippocampus and into the appropriate memory center. So, no multitasking when you need to concentrate! If you distract easily, try to receive information in a quiet place where you won't be interrupted.

- ✓ Relate information to what you already know. Connect new data to information you already remember.
- ✓ Organize information. Write things down in address books and datebooks and on calendars; take notes on more complex material and reorganize the notes into categories later.
- ✓ Understand and be able to interpret complex material. For more complex material, focus on understanding basic ideas rather than memorizing isolated details.
- ✓ Rehearse information frequently

and “over-learn”. Review what you've learned the same day you learn it, and at intervals thereafter. What researchers call “spaced rehearsal” is more effective than “cramming.” If you're able to “over-learn” information so that recalling it becomes second nature, so much the better.

- ✓ Be motivated and keep a positive attitude. Tell yourself that you want to learn what you need to remember, and that you can learn and remember it.

U.S thus is now getting more and

more protectionist and also trying to encourage the 'Reverse Outsourcing'...? Now the big question that arises is Can Bangalore sustain the status of an I.T hub for long time? What about it's 95lacs+ population if not so sustained?

However on the brighter side, our changing economic policies are such that they does not allow I.T sector to fall prey for such protectionist policies. Liberal and capitalistic economies favor Bangalore nevertheless there are fair chances of I.T sector to suffer, if dependence on outsourcing increases further. Even the strengthening of Indian Rupee against U.S Dollar in the mere future adds to it. If carefully observed, the domestic market is growing enormously and if this is

targeted and preferred over outsourcing at least from now, we would be better placed a decade ahead.

Leaders in I.T sector like Infosys are exploring Chinese market (evident from recent plans of investing over \$400,000,000 in China by Infosys). If they succeed, as it seems to be, China can pose a bigger threat. It's just the abundance and versatility of Human Resource here at Bangalore that sustains and insulates from severe global competition.

Thus, Bangalore needs to equip itself to tackle with a major shift in global scenario as well as outsourcing.

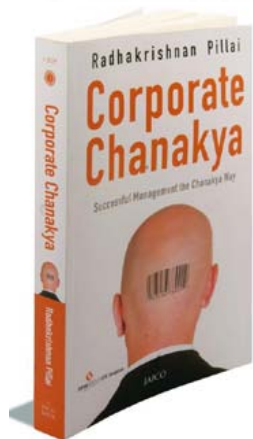
