

2018 Asian Games



The 2018 Asian Games, officially known as, XVIII Asiad / Jakarta–Palembang Games 2018, was a pan-Asian multi-sport event held from 18 August to 2 September 2018.

The Asian Games were co-hosted in two cities; the Indonesian capital of Jakarta (which is hosting the Games for the first time since 1962), and Palembang, the capital of the South Sumatera province. For the first time, sports such as esports and canoe polo were contested as demonstration sports.

Japanese swimmer Rikako Ikee was announced as the most valuable player (MVP) of the Games. There were 6 world, 18 Asian and 86 Asian Games records broken during the Games.

Neeraj Chopra, from India, was the flag bearer for the opening ceremony while Rani Rampal was named as the flag bearer for the closing ceremony.

India ranked 8th with total medal tally of 69(Gold-15, Silver-24, Bronze-30).



Creativity through Out of the Box Thinking – Part 1

“Thinking outside the box means to realize that there is no box. Those who do not think outside the box are easy to be contained and confined”



Life provides us with limitless and infinite possibilities, permutations and combinations. Confining ourselves to a particular path only limits our perspective and perception.






Word of the month: Fag

Fag- It's a verb


Meaning- Work hard, especially at a tedious task

Concept : Tick Index

This refers to a financial indicator that shows the number of stocks, or any other financial security, in an index that during any particular moment of the day are trading above or below their last closing price. It is calculated simply by subtracting the number of stocks showing downticks from the number of stocks that are showing upticks during the day. The tick index is one of the many indicators used by traders to gauge the general mood of the market. It gives traders a good idea of the general breadth of a market advance or decline, which can have an impact on their trades.


