Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan (5 September 1888 – 17 April 1975) was born in a Telugu-speaking Niyogi Brahmin family, in Tiruttani in Madras Presidency. He was an Indian philosopher and statesman who was the first Vice President of India and the second President of India.





Radhakrishnan studied philosophy by chance rather than choice. Being a financially constrained student, when a cousin who graduated from the same college passed on his philosophy textbooks into Radhakrishnan, it automatically decided his academic course.

One of India's most distinguished twentieth-century scholars of comparative religion and philosophy. He has been influential in shaping the understanding of Hinduism, in both India and the west, and earned a reputation as a bridge-builder between India and the West.

Radhakrishnan was awarded several high awards during his life, including a knighthood in 1931, the Bharat Ratna, the highest civilian award in India, in 1954, and honorary membership of the British Royal Order of Merit in 1963.





When he became the President of India, some of his students and friends requested him to allow them to celebrate his birthday, on 5 September. He replied, Instead of celebrating my birthday, it would be my proud privilege if September 5th is observed as Teachers' Day. His birthday has since been celebrated as Teachers' Day in India. Radhakrishnan believed that "teachers should be the best minds in the country"


Word of the month: Rendezvous
